## Fire Risk Assessments

Number	Benefit	Result
1	Site	Describe your site and investigate the best and most safe ways of evacuating
2	Fire Hazards	List the most common and most dangerous hazards on site, ask people, search cupboards, ask the silly question why is a motorbike with a full fuel tank leaning up against the smokers shed?
3	People at Risk	Are they young, fit, aged or even infirmed. How can you evacuate these people at night? Down Stairs?
4	Evaluate – Remove, Reduce	Remove potential danger, reduce risks
5	Equip	Provide alarms and fire fighting equipment if they can use it?
6	Advice	Ask your local Fire Service to visit and pass comment on your proposals
7	Publish	Create relative and long lasting signage
8	Train	Formally train those that need it and record it
9	Record	Record tests and evacuation drills, & if your equipment is in place and serviceable
9.5	Review	Regularly review you finds, companies and locations change which changes your risks
